Picnic Pavilion Rentals

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
- The park is closed to the public from 10:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.
- No person shall operate or use radios, phonographs, or other sound producing equipment in any area of the park or lake which is audible beyond the immediate vicinity that may disturb other park guests.

- The park manager or lake manager or his representative may, at his discretion, cause the removal or limit the stay of person(s) and/or vehicles causing any disturbance or in any way creating a nuisance.
- No person shall sell or offer for sale any merchandise, articles or things whatsoever, without written consent of the Executive Dir. of the MDWFP or his designee.
- No open fires in the day-use/pavilion area.
- Swimming is allowed **ONLY** in the designated areas.
- No pets are allowed in or near the swimming area.
- No person shall gain admittance to or attempt to gain admittance or remain in a facility within a park or lake for which a charge is made without paying the fees. An entry fee of \$3.00 per vehicle, up to six people is required upon entrance of the park.
- No owner or driver shall cause or permit a vehicle to stand anywhere outside of designated parking areas.
- Persons with pets in designated areas shall be required to restrain them on adequate leash, not more than six (6) feet long. Pets that **DISTURB** guests will be removed from the park. Persons with pets shall pick-up and properly dispose of excrement deposited by pets.
- No one shall use portable generators.
- No one shall use metal detectors.
- No person, except children six (6) years of age or younger, shall use restrooms designated for the opposite sex.

- No person shall commit any obscene, indecent, unsanitary, or offensive acts, such as urination or defecation in places not officially provided.
- No person shall use comfort stations except in a clean and sanitary manner.
- No person shall dress, undress, or indecently expose his/her person in any area of the park or lake where the same may be seen by another person.
- Bicycles are permitted on state parks. All bicycles shall be restricted from use after dark unless equipped with functioning headlights and reflectors.
- The operation of off-road vehicles including, but not limited to motorcycles, ATVs, trail bikes, dune buggies, go carts, and four-wheel drive vehicles shall be in designated areas only. Paul B. Johnson Park **DOES NOT** have designated areas.
- All motorized vehicles, whether it be electrical, gas, diesel, or other used within the state parks must be operated in compliance with state regulations for their operation. Such vehicles must be licensed and must conform to all state laws and regulations. Operation of unlicensed vehicles or vehicles that cannot be licensed by Mississippi law is prohibited.



PAVILION LOCATIONS

#27

is by the lake, near the Visitor's Center, has no electricity and no water. This pavilion has 4 picnic tables and a BBQ grill.

#29

is very close to the lake, near the Visitor's Center, has electricity and water. This pavilion has 4 picnic tables and a BBQ grill.

#30

is near the Visitor's Center and parking area. It has 4 picnic tables, electric, water, and a BBQ grill.

#33

is by the bathhouse, just past the spillway, has no electricity but does have water. This pavilion has 6 picnic tables and a BBQ grill.

#34

is by the fishing pier, has electricity and water. This pavilion has 8 picnic tables and a BBQ grill.

#35

is by the wooden playground and swim area, has electricity and water. This pavilion has 8 picnic tables and a BBQ grill.

Prices for the pavilions vary in cost from \$30.00 to \$65.00 a day. All pavilions are covered. Please contact the park office as to the exact cost of each pavilion. Pavilions are rented by the day, from 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
